GENERAL INFORMATION

This booklet introduces you and your Troop/Company to the program for the Wellington International Camporee (WIC). The weekend is planned around basic scouting skills. We hope your youth will take an active part in everything offered and will take home some great memories.

Please note: There will be a **separate fee**, theme and event schedule for Venturers.

THE LAW OF THE CAMP IS THE SCOUT LAW.

In order to make the camp as enjoyable as possible for all participants the following information is necessary.

UNIFORM Full uniform is to be worn at the following times:
Arrival, Flag Break, Closing and Departure.

ARRIVAL The gate opens at 1 p.m. Friday, September 28, 2007. A Section representative is to inform **Camp Registrar** of your arrival to obtain your campsite. Those **Not Pre-Registered** will be assigned a site on an availability basis. Set up your campsite ASAP.

EQUIPMENT

At camp follow directions of parking and security crew. They will get you in quickly. We do suggest you pack all group gear in one or two vehicles. They will be directed to the drop off area. Personal gear will be carried from the parking area. Staff will move Troop trailers onto sites.

DEPARTURE

Before you move a vehicle, your gear must be packed and your site inspected to receive departure clearance. Sub Camp Chief at your site, upon site inspection, will return medical forms and give out your crests. Any medical forms not picked up will be destroyed. Please co-operate with our staff. They are doing their job to move you as fast as they can. We hope this camp will be one you will remember for a long time.

COOKING Cooking will be on stoves or barbecues. No open fires on sites. Fire pails and/or extinguishers must be in each campsite.

GARBAGE All garbage must be taken to the dumpster after each meal. Garbage bags are available from Headquarters.

FIRST AID A First Aid Station will be on site for the weekend. All sections should be prepared for minor cuts/bruises. **All accidents Must be reported to the First Aid Station.**

WATER Drinking water can be drawn from the outside taps. Do not use these tapes for personal washing or washing dishes. This is to be done at your site.

TREES **There will be no cutting or hacking trees in any way. There will be no gathering of firewood! Be careful of any small plantings around camp. This is a conservation area, please respect it. Remember to be wise in the use of your resources.**

MUSIC There will be no radios, tape players, etc. on Scout sites. Walkie Talkies are restricted to Camp Personnel only.

DUTY TO GOD

Sections are expected to have a blessing before meals. **Scouts Own will be held on Sunday morning at camp and all participants are expected to attend.**

SPIRITS The only spirit is the Scout Spirit.

WASHROOMS

Staff washrooms are off limits to all youth members. Kybos marked LADIES are for the use of females only.

WEAPONS AND FIREWORKS

Weapons of any kind and fireworks are not allowed in camp. Anyone found with either in their possession will be asked to leave camp immediately with their group.

EMERGENCY VEHICLES

Emergency Vehicles must be given the right of way immediately, this includes the Camp Vehicle when the light is flashing and the air horn is being used. This indicates an emergency.

FIRE LANES AND ROADWAY

Fire lanes and roadway will remain open at all times. Tents, gateways, guy ropes, etc. **MUST** be kept out of fire lanes.

TUCK SHOP There will be a Tuck Shop on site selling pop and some candy. It will be closed during meals, Opening, Closing, Scouts Own and Campfire.

VENTURER EVENTS

TO PARTICIPATE IN THE Venturer events each Venturer must refer to the Venturer Program enclosed. Any resources to be brought to camp (other than the traditional camp equipment) are listed in the program. The schedule for WIC will be followed for all joint activities, particularly: Opening, Closing, Scouts Own.

NO PETS ALLOWED WITH THE ONLY EXCEPTION BEING GUIDE DOGS

Leaders: Please ensure you provide an emergency contact number with information sent home with the youth.
