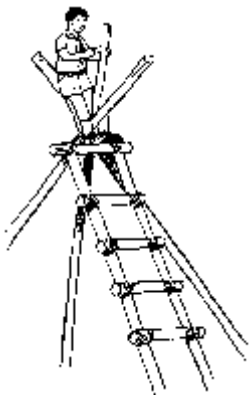

GENERAL INFORMATION

This booklet introduces you and your Troop/Company to the program for the Wellington International Camporee (WIC). The weekend is planned around basic scouting skills. We hope your youth will take an active part in everything offered and will take home some great memories.

Please note: There will be a **separate fee**, theme and event schedule for Venturers.

THE LAW OF THE CAMP IS THE SCOUT LAW.

In order to make the camp as enjoyable as possible for all participants the following information is necessary.

UNIFORM Full uniform is to be worn at the following times:
Arrival, Flag Break, Closing and Departure.

ARRIVAL The gate opens at 1 p.m. Friday, September 28, 2007. A Section representative is to inform **Camp Registrar** of your arrival to obtain your campsite. Those **Not Pre-Registered** will be assigned a site on an availability basis. Set up your campsite ASAP.

EQUIPMENT

At camp follow directions of parking and security crew. They will get you in quickly. We do suggest you pack all group gear in one or two vehicles. They will be directed to the drop off area. Personal gear will be carried from the parking area. Staff will move Troop trailers onto sites.

DEPARTURE

Before you move a vehicle, your gear must be packed and your site inspected to receive departure clearance. Sub Camp Chief at your site, upon site inspection, will return medical forms and give out your crests. Any medical forms not picked up will be destroyed. Please co-operate with our staff. They are doing their job to move you as fast as they can. We hope this camp will be one you will remember for a long time.

COOKING Cooking will be on stoves or barbecues. No open fires on sites. Fire pails and/or extinguishers must be in each campsite.

GARBAGE All garbage must be taken to the dumpster after each meal. Garbage bags are available from Headquarters.

FIRST AID A First Aid Station will be on site for the weekend. All sections should be prepared for minor cuts/bruises. **All accidents Must be reported to the First Aid Station.**

WATER Drinking water can be drawn from the outside taps. Do not use these tapes for personal washing or washing dishes. This is to be done at your site.

TREES **There will be no cutting or hacking trees in any way. There will be no gathering of firewood! Be careful of any small plantings around camp. This is a conservation area, please respect it. Remember to be wise in the use of your resources.**

MUSIC There will be no radios, tape players, etc. on Scout sites. Walkie Talkies are restricted to Camp Personnel only.

DUTY TO GOD
Sections are expected to have a blessing before meals. **Scouts Own will be held on Sunday morning at camp and all participants are expected to attend.**

SPIRITS The only spirit is the Scout Spirit.

WASHROOMS
Staff washrooms are off limits to all youth members. Kybos marked LADIES are for the use of females only.

WEAPONS AND FIREWORKS
Weapons of any kind and fireworks are not allowed in camp. Anyone found with either in their possession will be asked to leave camp immediately with their group.

EMERGENCY VEHICLES
Emergency Vehicles must be given the right of way immediately, this includes the Camp Vehicle when the light is flashing and the air horn is being used. This indicates an emergency.

FIRE LANES AND ROADWAY
Fire lanes and roadway will remain open at all times. Tents, gateways, guy ropes, etc. **MUST** be kept out of fire lanes.

TUCK SHOP There will be a Tuck Shop on site selling pop and some candy. It will be closed during meals, Opening, Closing, Scouts Own and Campfire.

VENTURER EVENTS
TO PARTICIATE IN THE Venturer events each Venturer must refer to the Venturer Program enclosed. Any resources to be brought to camp (other than the traditional camp equipment) are listed in the program. The schedule for WIC will be followed for all joint activities, particularly: Opening, Closing, Scouts Own.

NO PETS ALLOWED WITH THE ONLY EXCEPTION BEING GUIDE DOGS

Leaders: Please ensure you provide an emergency contact number with information sent home with the youth.

LEADER INFORMATION

REGISTRATION

The registration form attached to this booklet is to be received no later than September 14th, 2007. Campsites will be allocated as registrations are received. **If you have a "special needs" youth or leader, please let us know ASAP, as there are a few campsites reserved for this purpose.** Each participant is required to bring an up to date Medical Form, which will be handed in at Registration. **This should be the Physical Fitness Form for Canadian participants and the recommended for visiting groups.** These forms are available online on the Scouts Canada site. ***This form can be filled out online.*** <http://sunshine.scouts.ca/bpp/forms/parentconsent.pdf>. The medical forms will be retained at the First Aid center during the camp and will be returned at the end of camp with the crests.

ACTIVITIES Leaders may be asked to assist with events. All events have been assigned before the Camp but we may need your help to assist in the running of an event.

SCHEDULE The attached schedule is for everyone's guidance. We will follow the times as closely as possible. You and your youth can help by following the schedule also. Stress to the youth the need for good nights sleep both nights. Please post the schedule and provide it to you youth.

OFF LIMITS All water areas (i.e. beach, boat ramps etc.) are off limits unless there are sanctioned events taking place. Staff and Kitchen (Headquarters) areas are also off limits.

SLEEPING/SITE

Leaders will sleep on site, in separate tents, near the youth. **LEADER TENTS** must be identified. Sections will identify their sites.

CAMPFIRE All participants are expected to participate in campfire on Saturday night. Please inform your youth of proper campfire etiquette.

KYBOS Leaders are asked to help the camp staff to keep the kybos clean. Instruct your youth on the necessity of this and if you observe any problems please report them to the HQ area.

PICNIC TABLES

Picnic tables, one per site, will be available for this Camporee.

TRADING Badge trading will be just that **TRADING**, no money is to be exchanged. Please ensure that badge trading is a fair and pleasant experience for all.

THERE WILL BE NO SPORTS IN THE SUB CAMP AREA, the adjacent areas maybe used, AND NO FOOTBALL IN CAMP ANYWHERE.
